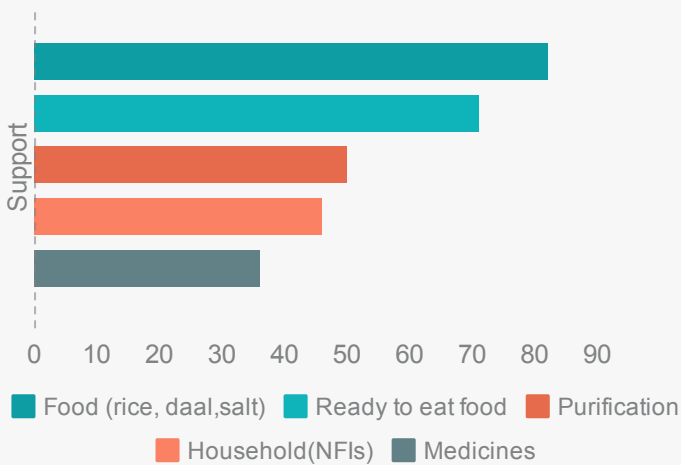


KEY IMMEDIATE NEEDS IN DISASTER

What do you think if households receive only **FIVE** kinds of support (i.e. Items or services) across all the sectors in a relief package within the first two week (0-14 days) after the disaster, what could be they?

The total of 5701 disaster affected people were surveyed for the key immediate needs assessment. The assessment covers 30 districts that are affected by disasters like earthquake, flood and drought in Nepal. The respondent were asked to think of five kind of support they would need in a relief package within the first two weeks of disaster and second two weeks of the disaster.

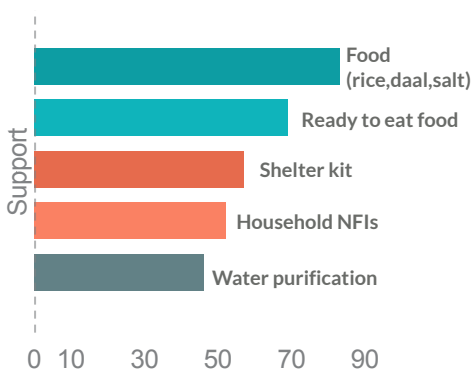

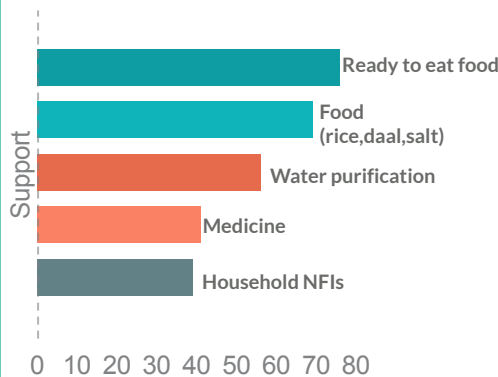

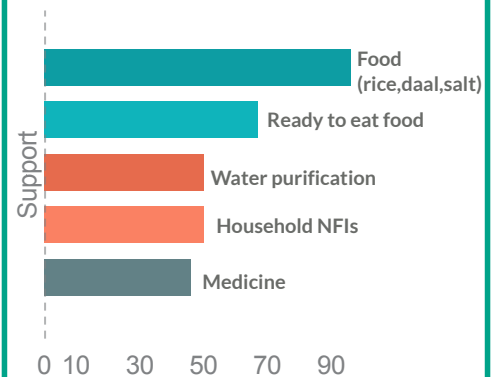

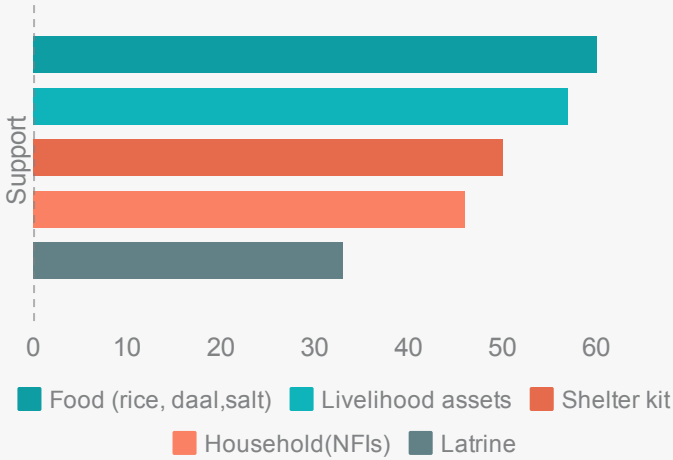

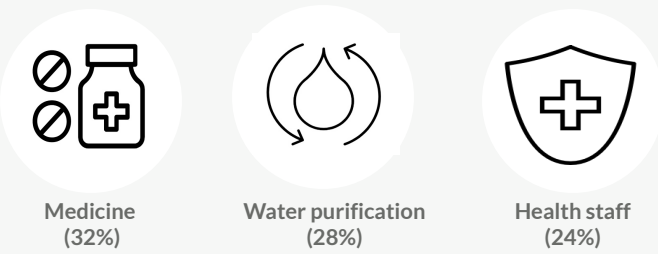

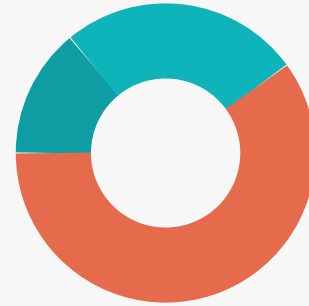
Five kind of support in a relief package within the 15-28 days



Other support in relief package

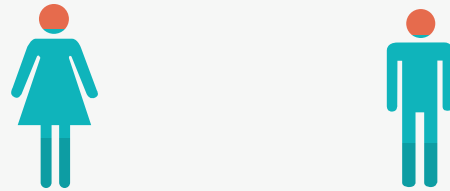


Would you prefer cash instead of items or both?

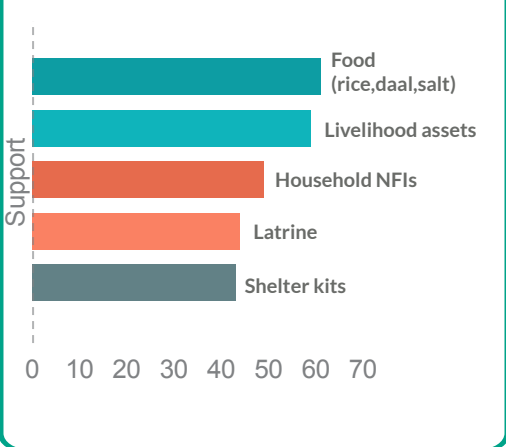
Disaggregation by gender



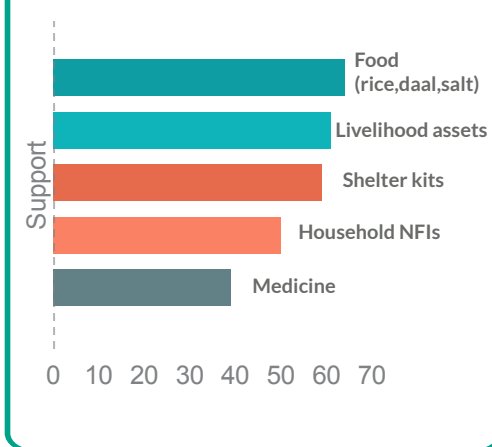
